Times: Gates open at 6.30 am

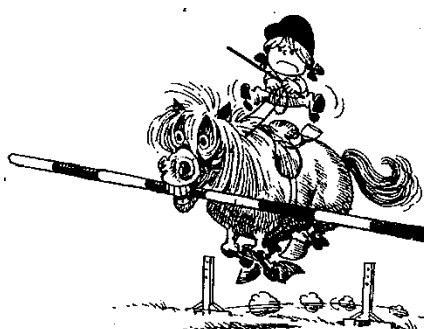
Canteen will be open for breakfast (and coffee to restore floating parents!) from 7.30 am
